



General Data Protection Regulations

Under legal regulations that come into force on 25th May 2018, we need to advise you that we hold certain personal information about you.

The information we hold about you comprises all or part of the following:

Name, postal address, telephone number, e-mail address, occupation and boat details and locations, evidence of ID and in some cases bank details at completion of the sale.

The information is stored manually in the form of your original Listing Agreement/Contract and subsequent legal documents and electronically on the Company's secure password protected computer.

This information is kept for the sole purpose of our contract with you and to enable us to contact you solely for matters pertaining to that contract.

We do not share your information with any third parties or carry out future marketing or mail-shots. The only exception to this would be a lawful request by HMRC or the Money Laundering Authorities in the event of an investigation.

On completion of the sale of a vessel the information held of both the purchaser and seller is securely archived for a period of 6 years, as required by law for HMRC purposes or in the case of ownership/title dispute of the vessel.

In the case of a vessel being withdrawn from sale the information will only be held for a period of 12 months after which it will be destroyed.
